Beautiful Saanich


The ideal setting to live and learn


The capital city of British Columbia is Victoria. Vancouver, with a population of 2.4 million, is British Columbia's largest city and is located on the mainland. It is just a short 15-minute flight or approximately two and a half hours from Saanich Schools by car/bus and ferry.

Vancouver Island offers a very mild climate—warmer winters and cooler summers, compared to the rest of Canada. Greater Victoria winters are rainy (but only 60% of the rainfall of Vancouver) with the occasional snowfall.

Student support and safety

SISP Homestay Coordinators provide on-going student support and monitoring with school based office hours (two days per week) and regular communication with host families. Every school has an assigned Homestay Coordinator, who is available via email and phone during school hours. During the evenings, weekends and holidays, students and host families can reach out to SISP Management, including a Homestay Manager by calling the SISP emergency phone. Student safety and support in Saanich is paramount.

The SISP homestay program is internally run by Saanich Schools employed Homestay Coordinators. The SISP homestay team carefully screens families from Saanich School's neighborhoods through an extensive online application, a criminal record check, and a home visit by a Homestay Coordinator to meet the family. A quality placement for every student is the priority and SISP ensures that students are placed in clean, caring homes. Homestay staff put extensive thought and care in matching students with compatible host families, always taking into consideration student's interests, dietary needs, allergies, and preferences.

All homestay accommodations include:

- A furnished room with an outside window
- A bed with clean linen (sheets, pillow, and blankets)
- Access to a shared or personal bathroom with clean towels
- Access to the common living area of the home
- A quiet, heated, and well-lit study space
- Three meals per day (breakfast, lunch and dinner) plus a healthy snack
- Interaction with family and family activities
- Pick up and drop off at Victoria International Airport (YYJ) or BC Ferries

Each year students have the opportunity to participate in a variety of exciting trips and activities

Throughout the school year there are a number of special student activities. Some include a visit to Tofino where students enjoy bear watching and surfing. Other favorite adventures include visits to Vancouver, quaint Coombs and Cathedral Grove Park, home to some of the world's biggest trees. Skiing at Whistler, Mount Washington or a Rocky Mountains trip to Banff. 


Outstanding Academics

Saanich Schools offer the opportunity to study in a small, medium or large high school. The core academic areas are standard across each high school providing international students with the ability to graduate with a BC Dogwood graduation certificate after two or more years of study. Additionally, studying for a shorter period of time, one semester to a full year, to obtain transcript legalization upon return to their home country is possible. Both options share a culture of inclusion and high academic rigor.

Saanich Schools welcome a wide range of English Language Learners (ELL). The academic support and rigor in Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) courses accommodates high achieving students while beginner and intermediate ELL classes are also offered in all high schools.

Advanced Placement Program

High schools in Saanich offer the required academic courses for graduation plus a variety of elective courses all adhering to the British Columbia (BC) Ministry of Education curriculum requirements. International students graduating from high school in Saanich will graduate as educated citizens, with the knowledge, competencies, and skills they will need to transition successfully into higher education, training, or the workforce.

Saanich Schools offer optional “Elective” classes in Arts, Business, Economics, Technology, Trades, Languages, and more. Expand your education and find your passion through these exciting classes.

Elective classes are a significant draw and new concept for many international students. The British Columbia Education system encourages students to pursue elective classes during middle and high school as a compliment to traditional academic classes. On your path to graduation you will need to complete fine art and applied skill electives, also known as “exploratory” classes in lower grades. Elective classes offer many benefits that help support international students development as well-rounded learners and individuals. Saanich Schools International Student Program support staff at Claremont, Parkland and Stelly's help you select and build your school schedule with a balanced compliment of elective and academic classes.

If studying for a semester, or one school year, elective classes balance your school day with more

rigorous academic courses. Review the chart for a specific elective subject that interests you and consider the corresponding school when applying to the Saanich International Student Program.

There are many clubs for international students to join in Saanich Schools. Clubs are offered before and after school, and during lunchtime. Clubs like the model United Nations (UN), Leadership, Math, Chess, and even Table Tennis are great ways for students to meet Canadian friends and improve spoken English. Greater Victoria and Saanich also have numerous community based clubs and activities you can join. 

SAANICH SCHOOLS have a long history of providing exceptional fine and performing arts courses for students. Each Saanich high school offers a wide range of courses in the arts, offering endless possibilities for students to pursue artistic expression.

STELLY'S HIGH SCHOOL offers the largest programs in Saanich for Jazz Band and Concert Band, and is the only school currently offering Film Studies. Stelly's combines courses in Stagecraft, Choir, Band, Dance, Drama and Musical Theatre to produce first class Musical Productions. Stelly's also offers courses such as Music Composition, Guitar, Visual Arts and Graphic Arts.

CLAREMONT HIGH SCHOOL has a one-of-a-kind Focus on Fine Arts (FOFA) program, offering a wealth of opportunities for students to deepen and display their knowledge and appreciation of the Fine Arts. Students can choose from a variety of disciplines such as Dance, Drama, music and visual arts, while being supported in their learning by specialized staff.

PARKLAND HIGH SCHOOL'S Musical Theatre production in semester one involves up to 90 students in all aspects of the show and typically runs for four nights to sold out audiences. Parkland also offers two different band options as well as Dance, Guitar and Graphic and Visual Arts.
